

## Birds in the Saginaw Bay Area

**Summary:** The summer season started out quite unsummer like with very cool temperatures in the early part of June. This cool weather which had extended from the latter part of May have been the reason for large numbers of migratory birds which normally pass quite quickly through the Saginaw Bay area to remain here for several weeks. The drought occurring in parts of the South and West may also have had something to do with the seemingly increasing numbers of vagrants from the South and West being observed in our area. The weather become more normal for late June and the entire month of July but the bird activity remained quite high.

Sightings of note during the period included: **Cattle Egret** (5) which have been coming to private property in Bangor Twp... in Bay county for the past couple of summers. Speculation is that they are nesting on the spoils island at the mouth of the Saginaw River and come to feed on this property. An **American Avocet** was observed at SNWR but evidently only for one day. A **Bell's Vireo** seen at Tawas Point, if accepted by the MRBC, may only be the second or third record for the SBA. Could this be the same bird seen in May, 2002 in Hampton Twp., Bay County? A **Carolina Wren** in Freeland, Saginaw County was another of the southern visitors. A **Blackpoll Warbler** in Gibson Twp., Bay County was quite late. A **Cerulean Warbler** in Arenac County is also further north than usual. The **Worm-eating Warbler** reported from Tawas Point may only be the third record for the SBA and is quite far north for this species.

The loss of the first brood of **Piping Plovers** at Tawas Point in a number of years to predators was sad but a reminder of how nature works and of the difficulties this endangered species faces in attempting to breed on the shores of the Great Lakes. Please note Gary Nelkie's attached write up on this loss.

The reporting activity for this summer period was relatively light so the resulting total species of 170 species was quite small in view of the evident high level of bird activity. Many of the species we would expect to be seen were not reported. My personal thanks to all of you who did submit your sighting records for the period.
