Birds in the Saginaw Bay Area August 1st, 2011 thru November 30th, 2011

Summary: An excellent total of 251species from the Michigan Bird List were reported in the SBA this autumn, the second highest ever for the season, which averages 234. This report lists each of these species, along with the highest reported individual count for each, first and last dates as applicable, and the SBA counties in which each was noted. Total observer effort was average in terms of overall coverage and number of days afield. There were fewer incidental observers than recently, and a few SBA regulars spent less time in the field, but anything lacking from this appears to have been made-up for by a handful of regulars that made thorough efforts. Birdwise, raptors seemed to be the only group that were slightly lacking in terms of numbers and variety. Seven new all-time SBA peak counts were established, two alone of which were for swallows. Two new fall high counts, one fall early date, and two fall late dates were reported as well. First ever SBA occurrences of Sabine's Gull, Pomarine Jaeger*, and Saltmarsh Sparrow* were reported. Equally impressive was the SBA's first ever multiple bird record for Western Grebe*.

> *Michigan Review List Species. Inclusion of records for these species in this report does not signify that they have been verified, only that an encounter was reported. The observation will not be considered an official SBA record until it has been reviewed and accepted by the Michigan Bird Records Committee (MBRC).

Weather: The persistent hot temperatures that made the summer unique lasted through the first one-third of August, but thereafter the month was average in both temperature and precipitation. September also got off to an unusually hot start, but this lasted only briefly. The remainder of the month's weather was dominated by two successive cut-off lows bringing dreary days that did little to brighten-up the month. In sharp contrast to the first days of September, the last days of the month saw northwest winds gusting to 40 mph, as a strong Canadian system brought the first chill of autumn to the area. As if not to break from the pattern being established for the season, a warm spell occurred during the first half of October, then temperatures returned to normal. Total precipitation for September and October were average, but the fact that rain fell on half of the days in these months made them wetter than normal in this respect. November temperatures ended up well above average, as an active storm track in the Ohio River valley blocked the typical northwest flow of seasonably cooler air. Shallow, protected bodies of water were just getting their first winter ice coverage at the month's end.






August, 2011 Weather Graph - Saginaw, Michigan (MBS)
