BIRDS IN THE SAGINAW BAY AREA

Summary:

A record 245 species were noted in the SBA this spring, 2 more than the previous high. Michigan's first Garganey appeared briefly by the river at Bridgeport one evening in late April. Unfortunately, it did not stay for the crowds the next day. Although unusual wildfowl are always dogged by the possibilities of being escapes, Garganey appear to have established a pattern of vagrancy across the US. The other state rarity this spring was a Glossy IbIs, again appearing only for one day at the exact same spot at Nayanquing as last year's White-faced. A Cattle Egret and a Little Blue Heron rounded out the rarer waders.

Two Eared Grebes were noted at the Dow Ponds, which now may be the best spot in the state to see this species. A Red-necked Grebe was also present there in April. Duck numbers were average, but a gathering of 10,000 Tundra Swans was impressive. No scoters were seen, and only two reports of Old Squaw.

Spring 1991 was the year that Huron County hawk-watching broke into the "big leagues". Thorough documentation by Monica Essenmacher and others has established that there is a significant passage of hawks along the bayshore of the Thumb. Final totals from 20 days (54 hrs) of observations were 5593 raptors including 921 Turkey Vultures, 7 Golden Eagles, 9 Bald Eagles, 45 Northern Harriers, 930 Sharp-shinned Hawks, 37 Cooper's Hawks, 62 Red-shouldered Hawks, 2770 Broad-winged Hawks (2119 in 3 days), 380 Red-tailed Hawks, 28 Rough-legged Hawks, 21 Ospreys, 53 Kestrels and 4 Merlins.

Shorebirds were sparse this year due to the lack of suitable habitat. Bay City SP provided a few good records (Avocet, Western Sandplper, Willet), other interesting records were a Piping Piover at Tawas, Avocet, Willet and Stilt Sandplper at Shiawassee and Marbled Godwit at Nayanquing. A remarkably early Dowltcher was seen on March 23. Gulls were represented by a single Little Gull and the now regular Lesser Blackbacked Gull at Bay City SP. There were more reports than usual of Glaucous Gulls, including a day count of 11 in Huron County.

There was an early burst of migration in the warm weather of late April producing a Prothonotary Warbler at Bay City SP and many early dates. Things slowed down for a few days, then a continual warm S wind in mid-May pushed everything through so that Alder Flycatchers were in by the 20th, traditionally the last migrants to arrive. This spell also produced Hooded and Kirtland's Warbler at Tawas on the 14th and 15th, and Olive-sided and Yellow-bellied Flycatcher there on the 17th, early dates for two migrants that are quite uncommon in the SBA (relative to S and W Michigan).

Big Days were run through the SBA on May 21 (Bob and Tom Kemp) and May 22 (Ron Weeks and Terry Walsh) yielding 183 (new state record) and 179 species respectively. Parhaps the most telling (and frustrating!) point is that the cumulative total for the two runs, which follow very similar routes, was an amazing 198 species!
