Summary:

This is traditionally a fairly quiet period but this year had a few surprises. The highlight must be the astonishing influx of Dickcissels throughout the SBA. It seemed that any suitable habitat had a few birds. Also, a good diversity of shorebirds were recorded for this time of year, 23 species in all. A Willet and a Lesser Golden Plover in late June and a Marbled Godwit in early July were rather odd, and 5 Red-necked Phalaropes in early June was a high number. Other species that appeared up in numbers were Sedge Wrens (often in the same fields as Dickcissels) and cuckoos.

A number of species were noted that are quite unusual in the SBA at this time of year. These included a Nashville Warbler in Tuscola Co, a Magnolia Warbler in losco Co. (possible nesters) and a Yellow-rumped Warbler at Tawas in July. Also a Common Loon, a Yellow-bellied Sapsucker and 2 White-throated Sparrows added to this northern flavor.

In closing, please don't forget to send me all the details necessary to document your sightings. This includes the *number seen, date* and *location*. It would be nice to get more specific locations for some records (eg. the nearest town cr crossroads) for future reference.
