Summary:

This summer period was probably one of the best we have had in the SBA with a record 191 species being recorded. The Nayanquing Point White-faced Ibis was undoubtedly the highlight (and probably the bird of the year) but was well supported by a Tricolored Heron, a White Pelican, Eared Grebes lingering from May, a Marbled Godwit and a record number of Avocets. The list was padded with a good range of ducks in the area and a nice selection of shorebirds, particularly at the Dow Ponds and Shiawassee where shorebirds returned "early and often".

The list of regular breeding birds was expanded with one or two species from losco County that undoubtedly nest every year but are not often recorded in this report eg. Lincoln's Sparrow. Several species of unusual warblers were also found in Huron County including Black-throated Blue on territory, Nashville, Cape May and Blackpoll. Other good breeding birds were Orchard Orioles and Least Bitterns in Bay County and a Western Meadowlark in Tuscola County. Numbers of Bluebirds, Cuckoos in some areas and Indigo Buntings were up but Ovenbirds were almost rare, and there were no Winter Wrens! A Carolina Wren finally put in a summer appearance, in addition to the recent midwinter records.
