

BIRDS IN THE SAGINAW BAY AREA

Summary:

The summer of 93 will probably be remembered for its waterfowl. An amazing 23 species including first summer records for Snow Goose (Nayanquing Pt), Oldsquaw (Tawas Pt), and White-winged Scoter (Tawas Pt). Adding to the waterfowl collection were six Tundra Swans, a few Pintails, a male Canvasback (now annual), and a male Bufflehead. Other impressive water birds included a Horned Grebe from Baldwin Twp in losco County, a Red-necked Grebe from Nayanquing Pt, Ba, Snowy Egrets from Nayanquing Pt and the Karn Plant, a Piping Plover from Tawas Pt, Willets from the Thumb and the Karn Plant, and a Godwit sp. from Tawas Pt.

Equally impressive in diversity if not quantity were the vireos and warblers. A record five species of vireos and twenty-six species of warblers were detected as residents or as late spring or early fall migrants. Late migrants included a June 4th Wilson's Warbler at Tawas, a June 5th Philadelphia Vireo from the Thumb, and a June 6th Northern Parula from Shiawassee NWR. Among the notable residents reported were Solitary Vireos (4 territories) and Blackburnian and Cerulean Warblers in the Port Crescent area and a Kirtland's Warbler from losco County. Early migrants reported from the last two days of July included Tennessee, Cape May, and Blackburnian Warblers from Tawas Pt and a Black-throated Blue Warbler from the Thumb.

The most surprising news among the residents was of a King Rail reported from Shiawassee NWR. This species has not been reported in the SBA since 1989. Other notables included Golden-crowned Kinglet and Louisiana Waterthrush from largo Springs, Swainson's Thrush (the migrant versus resident debate continues) and Mockingbird from the tip of the Thumb, and "new" Cerulean Warbler territories from Shiawassee and north of Midland.

Impressive counts included 227 Broad-wings from Port Crescent and 2500 Bank Swallows and 97 Bobolinks from Hampton Twp. In general, waterfowl numbers were lower, shorebirds numbers were down (largely due to lack of habitat, except for Shiawassee), passerines numbers were largely unchanged, and grassland species numbers were down slightly. Birds seen most summers that were absent for the period were Common Loon, Northern Goshawk, Redshouldered Hawk, Carolina Wren, and Lincoln's Sparrow. A total of 201 species were reported for the period.

AMERICAN BITTERN: 6/23 Kingston, Tu 7/20 Rose Is, Hu ME 2 7/27 Navanquing Pt, Ba TW, DC Immature bird. Also reported from Nayanquing Pt, Ba on 6/15 &16 (JS, MW). LEAST BITTERN: Finn Road Park, Ba 6/1 JS 4 6/11 Shiawassee NWR. Sa DP 3 7/27 Nayanguing Pt, Ba TW. DC Also reported from Nayanquing Pt, Ba on 6/11, 6/24, and 7/15 (MW). Bittern numbers seem to be holding steady or even increasing. High water may have increased habitat area. GREAT BLUE HERON: Fairly common tp. Reported from Io, Ba, Mi, Tu, and Hu. Peak of 58 on 7/23 at Shiawassee NWR, Sa (DP). Numbers down a bit. **GREAT EGRET:** Scattered sightings tp. Reported from Ba, Tu, Hu, and Sa. Peak of 23 at Shiawassee NWR, Sa on 7/29 (DP). Not as many as in previous years. SNOWY EGRET: 7/15-7/29 2 Karn Plant, Ba MW, KT, JS Nayanguing Pt, Ba 7/15 MW GREEN-BACKED HERON: Reported from Io, Ba, Mi, Tu, and Hu. Peak of 3 on 7/29 at Shiawassee NWR, Sa (DP). BLACK-CROWNED NIGHT HERON: Reported from Ba, Mi, and Sa. Peak of only 5 on 7/2 at Dow Dam, Mi (RW). Numbers were definitely down this year. TUNDRA SWAN: 7/1 Fish Pt, Tu MW Reportedly 4 birds here during the period. None were seen in flight (fide MW). Nayanquing Pt, Ba TW, DC 7/27 MUTE SWAN: 6/14 Eagle Bay, Hu ME 6/16 Dow Ponds, Mi RW SNOW GOOSE: Nayanquing Pt, Ba KK First SBA summer record. Kevin saw this bird in flight and estimated it to be about a third smaller than the Canadas with it. He could not specifically recall seeing black wing tips when asked about it two months later, but added that they may well have been present. CANADA GOOSE: Reported from Io, Ba, Mi, Hu, and Sa. Peak of 317 on 7/29 at Shiawassee NWR, Sa (DP). WOOD DUCK: Reported from Ba, Mi, Tu, Hu, and Sa. Peak of 28 on 7/23 at Shiawassee NWR, Sa (DP). The bird was flushed from about 10 meters away, but the morning sun did not allow them to see plumage detail. The bird was identified by shape and size only. It was described as the size of a Green-backed Heron with a thin head, long bill and a rather predominate eye. The observers are very familiar with Virginia Rail and feel confident in their identification. The normal refuge marsh areas have been flooded this year creating limited rail habitat. This high water situation in the late 80's also kept the birds in pockets of habitat that contained King Rails at Nayanquing Pt, Ba. Attempts to obtain a vocal response from the Shiawassee bird the next day were fruitless.
