Weather: The SBA winter weather and the rest of the nation has been unseasonably warm for yet a third year in a row. The first nine days of December were eight degrees above normal. Colder weather settled in for a period of time but the overall monthly normal highs for both December and February were noticeably above normal. (See table below for Saginaw stats.)

This winter has been the warmest since the government began keeping weather statistics 105 years ago, according to scientists at the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration. That is not surprising as the only real winter-like conditions occurred from roughly mid-January to mid-February.

Summary: The moderate, winter weather has once again produced overwintering birds that would otherwise be uncommon in harsher winters. The winter lingerer's included: Carolina Wren in Freeland; Winter Wren in both Huron & losco counties; Hermit Thrush mixed in with a sizeable flock of Robins in Saginaw in late January; Eastern Bluebird sitings in numerous locations in the SBA, and a White-crowned Sparrow in Hampton Twp, Ba.

> In a similar manner, early returning migrants included: Turkey Vulture in Vassar (2/29); fifteen species of waterfowl by the end of Feb on the Saginaw Bay or at Shiawasee NWR; Sandhill Crane at Shiawasee NWR (2/29); Killdeer in southern Bay County (2/25), and 3 American Woodcock in Hampton Twp and one in Mayville (2/26).

Notable birds for the period included: Red-necked Grebe @ Tawas Pte; Greater White-fronted Goose @ Shiawasee NWR; Ross' Goose @ Shiawasee NWR; two Northern Goshawk reports from Vassar and Hampton Twp; Merlin @ Tawas Pte; Carolina Wren @ a Freeland bird feeder; Northern Mockingbird in Saginaw that apparently overwintered; three Bohemian Waxwing reports from Vassar, Saginaw and Caro area; White-crowned Sparrow @ Hampton Twp, and finally, three Hoary Redpoll records from Myles Willard which is my nemesis bird. Noticeably absent for the period was any 'good gulls' such as Iceland's, Kittiwake, and even Glaucous.

New SBA Peak counts included: 96 Mute Swans on 1/24 @ the Karn Plant; 7 Great-horned Owls on 1/2 in five separate woodlots in Hampton Twp; 11 Short-eared Owls on 12/21 @ Shiawasee NWR, and a remarkable 110 House Finch on 12/29 at a single feeder near Fish Pte.

New SBA Spring Early Date included: 3 American Woodcock on 2/26 in Hampton Twp and one on the same date in Mayville.
