Birds in the Saginaw Bay Area

Summary: As is typical for the summer season, daily observer effort was less than the other three survey periods. Overall coverage was okay, with all counties receiving at least some attention, although some, such as Huron, and to a lesser extent losco, seemed a little shy on the attention they deserve. Recent efforts to explore less frequented areas of Arenac and Midland County continued in summer '09, providing insight into the birds breeding in these areas. Species whose numbers were reported in above average numbers included Veery. Nashville Warbler, Cerulean Warbler, Ovenbird, and Acadian Flycatcher. This last species was also reported from more locations than usual. Unusual summer encounters included Willet, Golden-crowned Kinglet, and White-crowned Sparrow. American Coot seemed to have been relegated to the ranks of the (unfortunately) overlooked common species this summer, being reported from only one county. Be they common, or rare, a total of 183 species were reported for the summer, one above the 1989-2008 average.

> For the first time in over twenty years, Chippewa Nature Center in Midland is not involved in the production and distribution of The Birds in the SBA seasonal report. Due to Email, PDFs, the internet, etc., assistance from CNC and its staff became an unnecessary step. Albeit relatively small, relieving CNC of responsibility for the distribution of season's end reminders and the final report provides them a cost savings as well. The U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service (USFWS) is now providing all of the elements - computer, email, server, paper and postage; necessary to compile and distribute the report, except the actual time and effort of the compiler. The value of CNC's contribution to the Birds in the SBA seasonal report is significant. With the support of the Center and its staff, over two decades of information on the comings and goings of migratory birds in the SBA have been collected and placed on record. True, this is a short period of time in some resects, but as the Carolina Parakeet, Brown-headed Cowbird, etc. illustrate very clearly, changes occur with comparative extreme rapidness of the "age of human-influence", and they can be quite dramatic. Thanks to CNC, USFWS, and the efforts of numerous volunteer compilers over the years, this report continues to represent a non-exclusive opportunity for contributors and readers to understand, appreciate, and conserve Birds in the SBA.

Weather*: The above normal precipitation pattern that had prevailed in the SBA throughout nearly all of 2009 continued unabated in June. Temperature-wise, the first two-thirds of the month were below average, with summer-like temperatures arriving near the same time as the first calendar day of the season. The wind seemed notably persistent throughout much of the month, which can make completion of BBS routes a challenge. July 2009 was notably cool, indeed the coolest ever in Saginaw County since official records began in 1900. Daytime highs never exceeded 85 degrees. Unlike the first half of the year, precipitation was slightly below normal in July. Plenty of sunshine, coupled with the lack of scorching heat, and only a few isolated occurrences of the severe storms that are otherwise typical of July, made for a very pleasant month.

^{*}Weather is based upon the best available data from NOAA, which is for Saginaw MBS. While generally applicable to the greater SBA, conditions in the northern and thumb portions of the area may have varied to some extent.


