Birds in the Saginaw Bay Area

December 1, 2003 through February 29, 2004

Weather: The weather for the winter period (MBS weather statistics) produced some unusual weather patterns, including a mild December, an uncommon winter thunderstorm on January 2nd, and higher than average snow totals for each of the three months.

December's average high for the month was 36.1, which was 4.1 degrees above the normal high. There were twenty days during the month where the average high & low remained above the average. There were three days with snows exceeding two inches but that snow melted shortly afterward due to moderate temps that followed. The Saginaw River remained open for the entire

January 2nd & 3rd matched record highs for the date but then the temps dropped to below normal for the remainder of the month. The Saginaw River didn't completely freeze over until January 8th compared to December 3rd for the previous winter. Nighttime lows reached zero degrees or below on twelve days in January including one stretch of seven consecutive days of zero or below. The coldest temp for the month was on January 25th at -12. Impressive snowstorms also highlighted January on the 14th (7"), the 17th (4"), and the 27th (5").

February's daytime highs remained fairly consistent with the average high for the month but the nighttime lows crept below the average low on sixteen days. Appreciable snows occurred in February on the 3^{rd} (2"), the 6^{th} (3"), and on the 23^{rd} (4").

Summary: 110 species were reported for the winter period, which is the highest total since the winter of There was an unprecedented number of shorebird species that lingered into December due, in large part, to the milder weather that held for the first half of the month. No less than six (6) shorebird species were reported, which far outnumbers past winter reports for the SBA. Additionally, nine (9) gull species were reported, which matches the highest ever winter number from '97-'98, including an SBA first ever Slaty-back Gull (pending MBRC acceptance). The SBA's second record of a Rock Wren (Same one from October @ Nayanquing Pt?) was another great SBA find. Winter finches, once again, were lacking in the SBA.

Notable birds for the period included: All three Scoter species including two December Black Scoter reports; Golden Eagle at the usual SNWR, SA but also one adult reported at Fish Pt, TU; Gyrfalcon at Fish Pt, TU; Peregrine Falcon at Carrolton, SA; Purple Sandpiper at the AuSable River Mouth, IO; Iceland Gull at SNWR, SA and Zilwaukee Bridge, SA; an SBA first record of Slaty-backed Gull on the Saginaw River, BA; Short-eared Owl reports in three different counties; a cooperative Rock Wren at the AuSable River Mouth, IO; Bohemian Waxwing at Grindstone City, HU; Chipping Sparrow in Bangor Twp, BA; Eastern Meadowlark in Garfield Twp, BA, and Evening Grosbeak at Cook Dam, IO.

New SBA Peak counts included: 246 Wild Turkeys on 02/15 on Five Mile Rd, near Gordonville, MI.

New SBA Fall Late Date included: Killdeer on 01/09 @ Karn Plant. Ba: - Dunlin on 12/21 @ AuSable River Mouth, IO, and **Pectoral Sandpiper** on 12/19 @ Finn Rd Pk,
