Birds in the Saginaw Bay Area December 1, 2002 through February 28, 2003

Weather: This winter's bone chilling temps were well below the above normal temps of Winter '01-'02. See table below for comparisons. The Saginaw River froze completely over on December 3rd, which was one month earlier than the previous year. It did open briefly in mid-December due, in part, to shipping traffic but quickly froze over and remained frozen for the remainder of the winter period.



In addition to the average daily high comparisons, the overall temps for each of the three months fell below the normal average for each month. December was 1.9 degrees below December's monthly normal, January was 3.1 degrees below January's monthly normal, and February was 5.2 degrees below February's monthly normal.

Precipitation for the three-month period of Nov/Dec/Jan, as reported by WNEM, was the driest on record, which was evident in much of the Midwest. Precipitation for the three-month, reporting period of Dec/Jan/Feb was 3.28" below the normal amount for this time period. There were only three days for the entire three-month period where it snowed over two inches, Dec. 25th with 3.2", Jan. 28th with 2.7", and Feb. 24th with 2.9".

Summarv:

Past winter weather and current weather played a part in the species observed for this time period. With several previous milder winters, a number of species that normally migrate out of the SBA remained well into the winter period, i.e. **Tundra Swan, Carolina Wren, Hermit Thrush, American Robin, Yellow-rumped Warbler, Eastern Towhee, Vesper Sparrow, and White-throated Sparrow.** Other species that occasionally show up with Great Lakes freeze-ups made appearances at Consumer's Hot Ponds in Bay County (and other areas of the state), i.e. **Common Loon, Red-throated Loon, Red-necked Grebe, Horned Grebe, and Western Grebe.** (Blue areas on the Great Lakes represent the only open water as of 02/20/03. Both Lake Huron & Lake Superior totally froze over in early March.)



Notable birds for the period included: (In addition to the above mentioned species) White-winged Scoter & Black Scoter on the Consumer's hot ponds, Bay County; Turkey Vulture in Saginaw County; Western Gull on the Bay City Christmas Bird Count (a possible first state record); Carolina Wren from three different counties; Bohemian Waxwing in Huron County, and, last but not least, a Spotted Towhee in Huron County, which was a new state record. Noticeably absent for the period was winter finches.

New SBA Peak counts included: 56 Trumpeter Swans on 12/21 @ largo Springs; 98 Mute Swans on 2/27 @ Hampton Twp, and 63 Bald Eagles on 01/10 @ SNWR.

New SBA Fall Late Date included: Ross' Goose on 12/26 @ SNWR, SA & Vesper Sparrow on 12/06 in losco County.
